Short Report:

Ms. J experienced numerous traumatic experiences in her life. For instance, she endured finding a parent that had died. She was very clear: her life was hard. The troubled life led to anger, and a large majority of that anger was at herself. Ms. J also believed a significant lie about herself: she shouldn't get anything good in life, especially God's love. It was a struggle for her to even believe that Jesus' death on the cross applied to her specifically. During a ministry session, Ms. J chose to confess to God that she was indeed believing a lie about herself. The Living God met her in a real way and showed her two pictures that had a powerful impact for her. First, He showed her Jesus on the cross and made it clear that His death applied to her. Second, He showed her the Resurrected Jesus. He is alive; she too lives because she is His daughter and belongs to Him! For a person who struggled with feeling any worth, this moment in a ministry session brought tears of joy. She began to see that she is lovable and worth loving!

Something to Consider:

John 14:19—*Before long, the world will not see me anymore,
but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.*

What is the point of living? For many who come to *Life of Freedom Ministries* for help, this is a question that is being contemplated. Sometimes, these words aren't the exact words that the person

shares with me, but the thinking and attitude about life is there. It is very sobering to hear about the horrors that people have endured, and they simple don't believe they can go on anymore. They need a personal encounter with God.

Now, let me make it clear, I'm not God! Like the men in Mark 2 who helped a paralyzed man to Jesus, I'm blessed to able be to help hurting people to Jesus too. For example, I was able to help Ms. J to Jesus. She was seriously hurting, and didn't really believe that she was lovable or that God loved her. She certainly believed that Jesus is the Savior, but she also believed the lie that she still wasn't good enough. The enemy had bound in her many ways. We spent the majority of a ministry session on the truth that she lives because He lives. I had given some "homework" in the previous session: papers to read that affirmed her identity in Christ and all of the blessings of being "in Him." The homework was helpful for her to comprehend the truth God showed at this ministry session.

Once this lie was addressed, we could tackle some other lies that were connected to the first lie. She now has hope and knows that there is indeed a purpose for living! For Ms. J, even some of the physical ailments ceased while in the ministry session. Was the cessation of the ailment due to demons leaving or response to emotional relief...or both? I don't know, but the joy on her face as she was leaving was wonderful to see. I look forward each day of ministry to seeing God bring healing in this fashion.

Prayer Concerns:

Scheduling in the summer can be challenging, as both the clients and I take some time off for family events. My prayer is for scheduling to work out, and for the flow of ministry to not be hindered by any breaks.

Some clients are not quite as local as most and travel long distance. Please pray for their travel times as well as the sessions.

Final Thoughts:

John 14:19 is a verse that stands out to me. I enjoy listening to the radio broadcasts of Ravi Zacharias, and he often mentions how this verse changed his life. Many times in ministry, I see how God is at work making the new life in Christ very real for a person. In fact, I seek to experience that each day myself. What a marvelous thing it is know that because He lives, I do too! I hope that you can experience it as well. Have a great June!
